

Ling 110 - Introduction to Phonetics and Phonology.

Course Project Interim report. - Due Sept. 20.

The purpose of this interim report is to ensure that you are started on the course project and that you are already working on this semester-long research endeavor.

1. If you are working on a language description project as outlined in the “Course project Ling 110” handout, your interim report should be a draft of section one “the language and language consultant” as described in that handout. In addition to your draft of section one, please describe one sound in the language with which you have had some difficulty in saying or in phonetically transcribing. The aim here is to show that you have started the process of working with your consultant, learning to say and phonetically transcribe words from the 200-word list.
2. If you wish to propose a customized course project, describe your proposed project with some detail as to the methods and rationale (hypotheses, aims) for the study, and give some indication that you have begun this study by giving some small tidbit of preliminary data.
